Sports Poomsae Class:	For more experienced competitors of all ages Colored belts and black belts who do world Taekwondo poomsae
Para Poomsae Class:	For athletes with special needs of all belts and ages To build tournament experience and gain confidence Available only for individual event
Open Poomsae Class:	For athletes of all belts and ages who do old Taekwondo forms/ ITF forms. Available only for individual event

#### Traditional and Sports Poomsae Classes will hold THREE events: Individual, Pairs, and Team

Traditional Poomsae Class:

- Open to all ages and belt level: Individual, Pairs and Team
- No gender restrictions in forming pairs or teams
- No age restrictions in forming of the pairs and teams
- All belt combinations are allowed in forming of the pairs and teams
- Pairs consists of only 2 members
- Teams can consist of 3 members
- Individual: must perform designated poomsae for your belt level
- Pairs/Team: Must perform designated poomsae based on level (Novice, Advanced, Black belt)

Sports Poomsae Class:

- Open to all ages, colored belts and black belts: Individual, Pairs and Team
- Pair has to be a female and male athlete of the same age group (17 years old and under OR 18 and above)
- Team will compose of only 3 members of the same gender, age group (17 years old and under OR 18 and above)
- Must perform designated poomsae per round (Preliminary, Semi-Final, Final)
- ONLY THE TOP 4 PARTICIPANTS will be awarded with medals ( only in sport Poomsae )

## Scoring:

Traditional Class: Scoring will be in the following order of importance:

- Individual: Presentation, Accuracy, TKD spirit
- Pair: Presentation, Accuracy, TKD Spirit, Synchronization, Teamwork
- Team: Presentation, Accuracy, TKD Spirit, Synchronization, Teamwork

Sports Poomsae Class: Will follow WT standards and rules

## General Information:

- Each competitor may register up to 7 events
- Individual Division will be separated into male and female competitors.
- If there are not enough registrants within one grouping (age, level, etc.), that group will be combined with another appropriate group closest to the level/age group.
- Correct AGE is calculated as follows: the year of the tournament, 2021 minus your birth year no matter which month you were born, i.e. 2021 – 1971 = 50
- Due to COVID-19 situation, masks can be worn when the competitor sees a need to wear them in any of the events: Individual, Pair, or Team
- Depending on the number of entries, they may be classified and grouped into a maximum of 4 players per group. They will be judged by selected International referees and be live streamed on YouTube platform. ALL PARTICIPANTS IN THIS EVENT WILL BE AWARDED WITH MEDAL!
- Due to various belt systems used worldwide, coaches/ athletes are expected to register in accordance to the respective poomsae prepared.
- If deemed necessary, the organizer reserves the right to change or modify tournament provisions not stated in the guidelines.

## Belt

- Athletes in Colored Belt categories MUST wear their appropriate corresponding colored belts for his/ her designated poomsae being performed. For athletes from a country with a different belt system, athletes may wear the belt color nearest their Geup.
- Pair and Team members can each wear their own level belts


During the tournament live streaming, the athlete's name with images of the school/club name, logo, national flag, video entry, scores, and award are reflected. By creating a school/club account, team representative can log in at any time and be able to view and manage their participants' data. Once a school/club has created an account, this will serve as the school/club's account in every competition managed by inthetms.com. Athletes' information is saved and can be updated any time.

## Procedure:

- Email your school/club name, email address, complete address, and logo to ongstkd@gmail.com or send the complete information via text to +1 (352) 438 9455 or +1 (352) 804 4120. For schools/clubs with multiple locations but with one logo, please register each school/club separately and indicate their respective addresses.
- 2. You will receive your User ID and password for your school/club within 48 hours. After which, you can log in and manage your team participants.

## **VIDEO GUIDELINES**

- 1. The Poomsae performance can be video recorded anywhere where there is space allowed for the performance of the Poomsae. Please ensure you follow the instructions of your local and national health authorities regarding social distancing and outdoor excursions.
- 2. Athlete must be 100% full body inside the screen of the recording for the entire Poomsae performance. 0.3 points will be deducted from accuracy for every movement performed with any part of the athlete's body out of the video frame.
- 3. Music is not allowed.
- 4. The video recording shall be done while the athlete is facing the camera in the start position. The camera must be stationary but may be rotated no more than 45 degrees left and right from its starting point as indicated in the diagram below. Zooming in and out during the performance is not allowed.



- 5. Videos that have been used in any other competitions will be disqualified.
- 6. Poor quality videos that are unable to be judged by the referees will result in the minimum score of 1.5 per Poomsae. Minimum video quality should be 720p @ 60fps. Suggested video quality is 1080p @ 60fps where possible. Video must be in LANDSCAPE orientation.
- 7. Performance should start with the correct Taekwondo etiquette before each performance. This will reflect in the final scoring as an element within Taekwondo Spirit criteria.
  - Procedure at the start of performance: Charyot, Kyungrae, Choonbee, Shijak
  - Procedure at the end of performance: Baro, Charyot, Kyungrae
  - Masters may help with announcing the actions for the students
- 8. Traditional Poomsae competitors shall record 1 video for each event between 30 90 seconds. Sports Poomsae competitors will make 3 separate videos for each event: one preliminary video, one semi-final video, and one continuous video with two designated Poomsae for the finals with approximately 30 seconds separating the two performances. Both performances for the finals should start and end with the correct Taekwondo etiquette.
- Title of video entry/ies should follow this format:
   2021 WC ATOP Athlete's Name Poomsae Gender and Division
   example: Individual 2021 WC ATOP Jane Doe Taegeuk 8 Female Cadet
   Sports Pair 2021 WC ATOP John and Jane Doe Preliminary M/F 18 and up
- 10. Videos must be uploaded on YouTube and saved as unlisted or PUBLIC setting. Paste the video YouTube link in the designated box of the event management page of inthetms.com.
- 11. A video with wrong player/s or registered in the wrong division will be disqualified.

## AWARDS

The E-certificates will be available as soon as the results are final. Medals will be sent to each Taekwondo school address or home address by regular shipment at no extra cost. Additional fee will be required if you want the medal shipment to be expedited with trace and tracking number.
