**Enrollment Deadline:** All registrations must be received on or before **April 20, 2023**.  
Registration at the door will be charged extra **\$15** late fee.  
Foreign competitors must register a month before tournament date.

**Additional Fee:** Adult and Children = \$15.00 5 yrs under = Free

**Coaching: Coaching will be allowed for all non-black belts. Parents who wish to coach their team must attend the mandatory coaching seminar. Non-Blackbelt and Coach-Parent fee is \$35.00 Foreign Coach Fee is \$70.**

There will be NO coaching for those who failed to attend the coaching seminar or did not register. Violators of this provision will lose their coaching privileges. Coaches are encouraged to register by completing the Coach Registration Form. **Local WTF Certified Master instructors and School owners are exempted from fees, but will still be required to fill out the coaching registration form.**

*\* The system will calculate total fees based on the number of events entered and the date of registration.*

## TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- **Traditional Poomsae Class:** For all belts and ages who do world Taekwondo Poomsae
- **Sports Poomsae Class:** For more experienced competitors aged twelve years old and up  
Black belts who do world Taekwondo Poomsae.
- **Para Poomsae Class:** For athletes with special needs of all belts and ages  
To build tournament experience and gain confidence  
Available only for individual event.
- **Open Poomsae Class:** For athletes of all belts and ages who do old Taekwondo forms/ ITF forms. Available only for individual event.
- **Sparring Class:** For athletes of all belts and all ages
- **Board Breaking Class:** For athletes of all ages with exceptional skills of strength and flexibility.

**Competition Rules:** The current WTF competition rules, USAT Junior Safety Rule for all Black Belts and Junior Black Belts only. For players aged 11 years old, the rules may vary upon the discretion of the tournament committee.

**Competitor Awards: POOMSAE, BREAKING & SPARRING players will be awarded a medal for 1st, 2nd & two 3rd place winners.**

**School Awards:** “Best Player Award”- Player who showcased extraordinary ability and with the highest approval rate from judges and referees.

**Mandatory Equipment:** WTF approved Taekwondo Uniforms Black V-neck for Black Belts only and white V-neck for non-Black Belts. All sparring competitors must wear WTF Approved headgear, red and blue reversible chest protector, forearm guard, fist gloves, shin and instep guard, groin cup and mouthpiece. Each competitor must provide his or her own equipment.

**Participants who will not wear their complete protection gear will be automatically disqualified.**

### Scoring:

Sports Poomsae Class: Will follow WT standards and rules

### General Information:

- Each competitor may register up to a **maximum of 7 events**
- Individual Division will be separated into male and female competitors.
- If there are not enough registrants within one grouping (age, level, etc.), that group will be combined with another appropriate group closest to the level/age group.
- Correct AGE is calculated as follows: the year of the tournament (2023) minus your birth year no matter which month you were born in, i.e. 2023 – 1971 = 52
- Considering the ongoing COVID-19 situation and additional precautionary measures, masks can be worn whenever the competitor sees a need to wear them in any of the events and inside the venue

### ALL PARTICIPANTS IN THE TRADITIONAL POOMSAE, OPEN AND PARA POOMSAE EVENTS WILL BE AWARDED WITH MEDALS!

- Due to various belt systems used worldwide, coaches/ athletes are expected to register in accordance to the respective poomsae prepared.





#### **SPARRING RULES**

- ALL Sparring competitors must wear WTF-approved Taekwondo Uniforms, Sparring Protective Equipments (Head Gear, Chest Guard, Arm Guards, Fist Gloves, Shin & In-step guard, Groin cap and Mouthpiece)
- Sparring Match consists of 2 rounds, each will last up to 1 minute. Time may vary in every division.
- Competitors who will not be wearing complete protective gear will be defaulted but will be given 60 seconds grace period to complete the required safety gear.

#### **SPARRING CATEGORY**

##### **Class A - Full Contact Sparring**

- Black Belt ONLY (12 & Above)
- Junior Safety Rules / USAT Safety Rules
- Light Head Contact ONLY

##### **Class B - Amateur Sparring**

##### **GAMJEUNG: All penalty points will be added to the opponent ( 1 point each deduction )**

1. Holding
2. Falling down
3. Out of bounds
4. Intentionally kicking below the belt
5. Attacking a fallen opponent after the referee has given the command to break or stop
6. Severely injuring the opponent's face or neck with a fist attack
7. Severely injuring the opponent by unauthorized or malicious attack
8. Unsportsmanlike conduct




